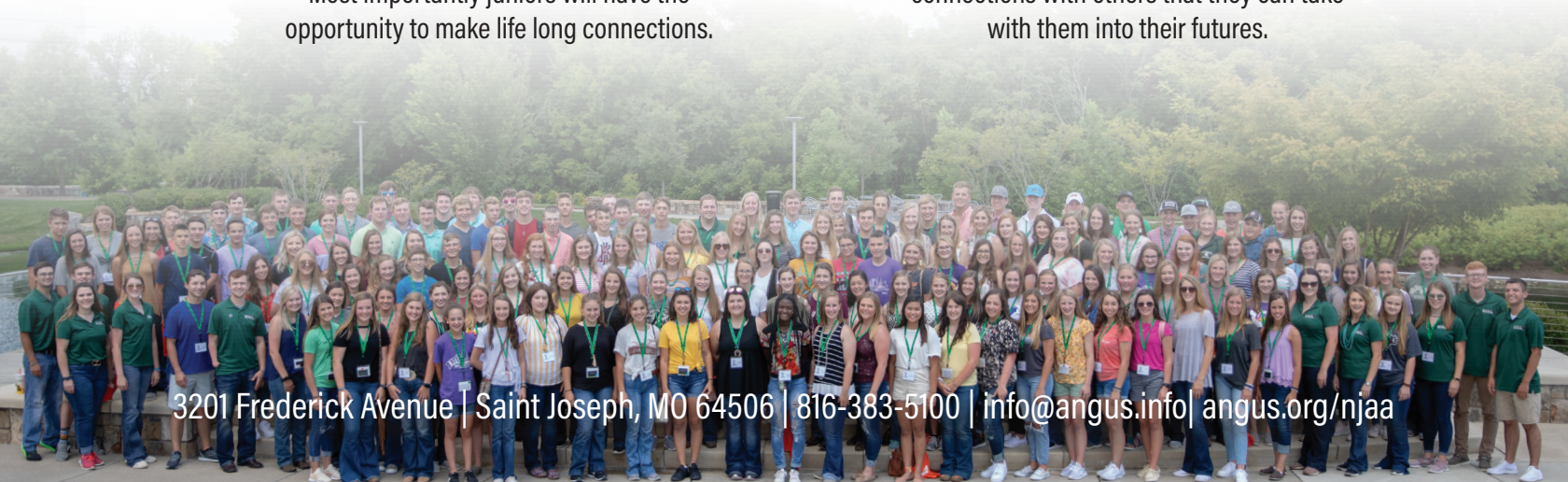
Leaders Engaged in Angus Development (LEAD)
